67 Your Oklahoma Bar Foundation is 67-years strong. Founded in 1946 by lawyer members of the Oklahoma Bar Association, the OBF is a proven charitable organization. Your OBF is the third oldest bar foundation in the Nation.

The OBF Court Grant Program was established in 2009 through a generous *cy pres* award with **33** counties receiving OBF court grant funding for technology equipment since establishment of the innovative new program.

90,000 Some 90,000 Oklahomans were helped by programs and projects receiving funding from the OBF last year, with over 3,000 pro bono volunteers helping to enhance the benefits provided by OBF grant dollars.

501(c)(3) OBF is a IRS Code philanthropic organization so that lawyers, law firms and other affiliates can accomplish law-related charitable good works statewide with tax exempt status through OBF.

8 law-students will receive OBF scholarship funding this year at all three law schools in Oklahoma.

13 OBF Court Grant Awards were made this year to help Oklahoma District and Appellate Courts.

30 programs and projects will receive OBF grant funding during **30** 2013 for 2014 services.

\$356,900 is the 2013 OBF Grant Award total plus an additional \$89,375 in 2013 OBF Court Grants and \$40,800 in scholarship awards. This year OBF was able to grant 56.5% of the total amount requested by returning applicants.

\$11,087,127 in total OBF grant awards have been made since founding, with \$10.5 million being given over the past 35 years. Fellows are the lifeblood of the Oklahoma Bar Foundation.
